



$$N \xrightarrow{(-)} Sister \longrightarrow M \xrightarrow{(+)} Brother \longrightarrow R$$




Hence, R is maternal uncle of N From (c) we get,




Hence, sex of R is not determined.

Hence, R is the nephew of N.


